LOKEPARA MAHAVIDYALAYA, a Govt. aided Degree College, affiliated under The University of Burdwan, having its own campus at P.O. - Kuliara, Dist - Birbhum, West Bengal, India - 731218, represented by Dr. Mrinal Kanti Das, son of Late Baidyanath Das hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns) OF THE OTHER PART.

5) Efforts will be made to jointly organise seminars, conferences, workshops, research or training programs in order to leverage on the other party's strengths.




